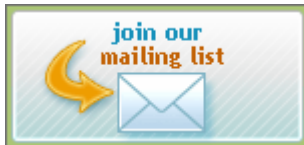

## In Sympathy

### **In Memory of Charles O. Walker**

Charles Orville Walker, long-time generous supporter of the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, died on Wednesday, December 1, in Jasper at the age of eighty-one.

Since 1960 Walker had been pastor or pastor-emeritus of FBC Jasper. During that half-century he was a denominational loyalist, a founding member of the Georgia Baptist Historical Society, a Baptist historian of considerable repute, a friend of many different kinds of Baptists, a student of Cherokee history and culture, and an artist whose focus was early nineteenth-century northwest Georgia life, both white and Native American.

At a moderate meeting in March 1992 he moved "that this group of Baptists organize themselves into the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of Georgia," and the motion was approved unanimously. Thereafter he served on the Coordinating Council, was faithful in his financial contributions, and held membership in the William Whitsitt Baptist Heritage Society.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Betty Anne, and a son, Paul. He is survived by a son, Mark, and his wife Mary, several grandchildren, one great-grandchild, a brother and his wife, and several nieces and nephews.

Memorial services were held at FBC Jasper on Sunday, December 5.

Cooperative Baptist Fellowship has lost a valued supporter. We express our heart-felt sympathy to his family.
