A Call for Sermons

As more women have been called into ministry, churches have begun to recognize the invaluable gifts, perspectives, and skills that women bring to the role of ministry. One particular talent for which women are being praised is that of preaching. As preachers, women bring a wealth of experience, emotion, and wisdom to the ministry of proclamation. And, dare it be said, that frequently women have a prophetic word for the church today. Thus, I would like to gather some of the words of women preachers together in one book for inspiration and challenge to those who read it. I am editing a book of sermons titled *And Your Daughters Shall Prophecy: Sermons by Women in Baptist Life*. Here are the guidelines:

- * All sermons must be submitted as a Word document.
- * All submissions must be 12 point type, double spaced, and no more than five to six pages in length.
- * Send submissions via email to massey_k@mercer.edu
- * Deadline for submissions is April 15, 2006.
- * All submissions must include the sermon title and text(s) at the top.
- * All submissions must include the name of the author and author's position of ministry.

Please note that there will be limited space in the book, so not all submissions will be published.
