



Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of Georgia 2012-2013 Scholarship Application Process

Application Requirements

- Student must be enrolled in a master's level degree program at an accredited institution (not restricted to Baptist institutions.)
- Student must demonstrate a connection to Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of Georgia.
- Student must show potential for leadership within the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship.
- Student must obtain three letters of reference in sealed envelopes and **include them with the completed application.**
 - CBF/GA Reference (i.e., pastor, someone to affirm CBF/GA connection/leadership potential)
 - Professor/Employer Reference
 - Personal Reference (a non-relative)
- Student must write an essay (three page maximum, double-spaced, twelve point font) addressing topics below and include essay with completed application form.
 - Faith Journey and Vocational Calling
 - Ministry Goals
 - Current Relationship to CBF/GA
- Former scholarship recipients may not re-apply.

Completed applications must be received annually on April 6, 2012. No applications accepted after the deadline. Award amount will be divided over two semesters and sent directly to recipients. It is mandatory that award recipients attend the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of Georgia Fall General Assembly.
