Hurricane Response Continues

CBF/GA and CBF Global continue to respond to needs in our state and beyond in the wake of the devastating hurricanes that have affected our region in recent weeks. As conditions improve enough for groups and individuals to engage in on-the-ground responses, CBF/GA will be communicating those opportunities to our partner congregations. Many of our churches are already responding to immediate need through contacts in the hardest-hit communities and counties.

Alan Williams, Disaster Relief Coordinator for CBF Global, says, "We will continue to provide updates when we have determined specific communities for CBF engagement, and we will share opportunities for network and congregational involvement. Our priority is to assist neighborhoods that tend to be overlooked during disaster recovery. *As we prepare for response efforts, please be advised that CBF Disaster Response is not capable of handling donations of food, water, clothing and other material goods.* However, we will be following up as quickly as possible regarding volunteer needs in specific communities." 
